

# INFORMATION WITH TSHEPISO

## UNIVERSITY APPLICATION GUIDE

### STEP 1: GATHER YOUR DOCUMENTS

Before starting your application, make sure you have the following documents ready:

- Certified copy of your South African ID or passport
- Grade 11 final results or latest Grade 12 results
- Proof of residence (letter from a local authority, utility bill, or affidavit)
- Contact details for your school

Having these documents ready will make the application process faster and easier.

### STEP 2: COMPLETE YOUR PROFILE

Provide accurate personal and academic information.

You will need to enter:

- Personal details (full name, ID number, date of birth)
- Academic history (subjects and results)
- Contact details (phone number and email address)
- Parent or guardian information (if required)

Make sure all information is correct before continuing.

### STEP 3: SUBMIT YOUR DOCUMENTS

Upload clear copies of your required documents.

Tips for successful uploads:

- Scan or photograph your documents clearly
- Ensure all text is readable
- Avoid blurry or cropped images
- Upload files in the requested formats (PDF or image files)

Incomplete or unclear documents may delay your application.

### STEP 4: APPLICATION REVIEW

After submitting your information and documents:

- Your application will be reviewed
- You may be contacted if additional information is required
- Applications will then be submitted to the selected institutions

Make sure your contact details are correct so you can receive updates.

## IMPORTANT DATES

Application dates vary by institution, but generally follow this timeline:

- Applications open: March/April
- Application deadlines: July - August (some later)
- Late applications: September/October (if available)

Starting your application early increases your chances of meeting all deadlines.

## COMMON APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Most universities require the following:

- ✓ Matric certificate or Grade 12 results (For those who have already completed Grade 12)
- ✓ Grade 11 Final results
- ✓ South African ID document (Including that of the Parent/Guardian in the case of a Minor)
- ✓ Proof of residence
- ✓ Academic transcripts or school reports
- ✓ Some programmes may require portfolios, auditions, or references

Always check specific programme requirements.
